#### 8: Any Other Business:

#### a. KAS Elections:

There was a small window of opportunity for members wishing to cast their votes and have the ballot retuned by 17<sup>th</sup> May or alternatively bring their completed ballots along to the AGM on 21<sup>st</sup> May.

#### b. Portable Antiquities Scheme:

JJ informed the meeting about the budget constraints that have been placed on her work in particular cuts to her travel budget. This has resulted in prioritising the PAS engagements so surgeries have been reduced from 4 to 3 per year which will be based in libraries which has opened the scheme up to a wider audience.

#### c. KAS2022:

Lees Court Estate: A presentation was given by CBM and CD together with Estate mapping and finds as a result of fieldwalking. The initial conclusion drawn was that there appears to be some very significant and possibly important prehistoric activity on the Estate with ring ditches and barrows being identified. It was agreed that CD CBM SW and AM will make arrangements to visited and discuss the next steps with our Patron.
